The mission of ACVV P.E. South is to develop, support & sustain disintegrated family units within poverty-stricken communities by the deliverance of strength based and capacity building programmes. ACVV PE South is a Family Care Organisation and was established by volunteers on 14 April 1927. The ACVV PE South is one of seven branches in Port Elizabeth. It is a non-political welfare organization and does not discriminate against religion, race, gender or creed. The mandate of ACVV P.E. South is to provide and facilitate effective and efficient service delivery to the vulnerable groups of society, the poorest of the poor, the marginalized and the disadvantaged groups in the working area. Projects that the ACVV South supports:

Buyiselekhaya: This project helps 120 underprivileged children with a daily soup kitchen in the Walmer Township. We took them off the Arlington Tip, where they were eating the rotten food and using the rubbish to make temporary shelters. We then enrolled them in school and provided regular skills workshops. We also provide empowerment and care for the children and their families, as well as the children orphaned by HIV AIDS.

Walmer Township Aftercare: Our Walmer ACVV sub office provides an aftercare service for 30 children aged 6 years, whose parents are illiterate and cannot assist them with school work. They are provided with a meal and a safe environment to play and learn while their parents work.

SeeMeeu Pre-Primary: Is a pre-primary school which has three grades, and takes in children aged 3-7. We have 3 qualified educators providing the best possible education and promoting the optimal development and healthcare of each child. We also provide an aftercare service for the parents who have demanding jobs.

9 Crèches in Walmer Township: The 9 Independent crèches in the Walmer Township that we support provide for around 40 children each. They have minimal facilities and some don't even have chairs or toys for the children to use. We therefore try to provide for these crèches so that the children can develop and play in a safe environment, other than the streets of the township.

Youth Groups: There are two youth groups consisting of 45 youth in total. We have skill workshops, life skills and team-bonding activities which the youth take part in regularly and it forms a learning environment for all.

Emergency Relief Packages: Throughout the year, we have families which approach us for help, in the means of emergency relief packages. Some of them have lost their jobs, a loved one or their homes and really don't have any other resources. They have children and pets, which they cannot provide for, so we make up a emergency package to help feed and clothe the family.

Christmas Food Packages: Every year we give out a minimum of 150 Christmas packages to needy families, so that they can have a meal on Christmas, for them and their children and their pets.

Back to School: Every year we assist children with stationary, school clothes and school fees to be able to continue their schooling. The school fees are a R 100 per year in the Walmer Township per child.

Sakhikhaya Lethemba and Abantwana Abahle Cluster Homes for Children: These two homes are under our mentorship, but are run by St John'

ACVV PE. South Events: The ACVV has many annual events, like our Women’s Day, our Christmas party, our March against abuse, our regional functions and outings for the children as well as various fundraisers.
