Caring Hands Foundation is a Section 21 non-profitable organisation (NPO) that raise funds for the various charity organisations for the Deaf in Gauteng, which are committed to improving the quality of life of the Deaf on social, spiritual, physical and material levels.

Caring Hands Foundation for Deaf and disabled Deaf

The organisation was founded in 2007 by Deaf leaders of the affiliated organisations. These outstanding individuals, who serve their fellow Deaf with passion, developed the ability to rise above their invisible handicap and use their talents to make their dreams come true. They manage the organisation effectively. 90% of Caring Hands' members are Deaf themselves and lay the foundation for the Deaf to be able to look after their own people.

House Carmen for disadvantaged Deaf

House Carmen is a small home which we use as a crisis/passage house for needy and jobless Deaf. The home is also used to accommodate self-sufficient elderly Deaf. Tariffs are extremely low.

This is a very urgent project mainly aimed at the Deaf, who, due to the current economy, became unemployed, and we want to ensure that they are cared for with an empowered lifestyle. There are 10 rooms including three double rooms, up to 14 people can be housed. Everything is in a nice homely setting with lounge, kitchen and dining room like any other house. Caring Hands had since the beginning of this year a controlling stake in the home and thereby making available lodging for the Deaf. At this stage, it needs some repairs but will get attention this year. The house next door is up for sale and we are currently seeking finances to obtain the property as we need to expand additional rooms.

The lodging of R2150 per month includes 3 full meals, clothes washing and ironing and room cleaning once a week. The House receives no subsidies from the state, and depends on donations from the community. We want to care for the deaf who cannot help themselves. The need is urgent, intense.

We need very urgently assistance of R1,750.00 per month per Deaf for the boarding fees. Your support for the Deaf will eventually lead to bring the best out of the life of the Deaf. You can be assured that the donations that we use to help you sow will fall on fertile soil and one day will bear good fruit in which our Lord will rejoice.
