Short case studies on selected projects

Afrox: access control and time & attendance (T&A) at a number of Afrox sites in Gauteng.

Broll Property Management: access control at the Standard Bank Centre in Cape Town. Some 5 000 tenants and hundreds of visitors access the building daily through biometrically controlled turnstiles.

Busby Retail: biometric T&A in 130 South African retail outlets. Sagem fingerprint readers linked to POS terminals – used in conjunction with POS PC and screen, allowing the company to leverage existing IT infrastructure rather than invest in dedicated biometric terminals. The stores transmit clockings to head office for payroll integration. Sagem terminals for T&A and access in distribution centres and offices nationwide.

City of Cape Town: configuring 600 Sagem terminals and enrolling 21 000 employees at 350 locations across the Western Cape. ***Probably the largest biometric T&A roll out in South Africa at present.***

Department of Agriculture: IT access control for PCs and password-protected applications. Incorporates a physical access control which is integrated and converged with the IT module. Ensures that staff cannot sign-on to a PC if they have not first entered through a pre-determined physical access point.

Midas: access control and T&A at Midas' head office, distribution centres and its wholly-owned retail outlets.

Medical Research Council: a web-based mini AFIS solution to record the identity of clinical trial participants. Prior to enrolling on a trial, participants have their fingerprints checked against a central database to ensure they have not enrolled under a separate identity as participation in multiple trials could compromise results / have health implications.

Mondi: biometric solutions deployed in all of Mondipak Packaging's factories in South Africa.

Swartland Municipality: one of 15 municipalities using our biometric access and T&A solution. Some 1 200 staff clock at upwards of 60 biometric terminals spread across 20 sites.

Department Rural Development and Land Reform: deployed IT Access Control into BAS, PERSAL, and LOGUS throughout South Africa across the whole department.
