



Pre-Photo Shoot:

1. Consultation

Long before the date of the shoot, you will meet with either one of our photographers or one of our sales staff. The consultation serves as the first step to ensuring your complete satisfaction with every element of the shoot. We will discuss the theme, hours, details and show you what the prints and canvasses look like, as well as work a package for you within your budget.

2. Confirmation of Booking

After the consultation, we will put a quote together for you. It's up to you to confirm your booking details with us and pay your 75% booking fee to secure your chosen date and time.

3. The Photo Shoot

On the agreed upon date and time, the shoot happens! If hair and make-up was agreed on for the shoot, please be sure to be at the studio a minimum of 1 hour before the agreed upon photo shoot time.

There are 2 main types of shoots:

Indoor Studio Photo Shoots These shoots will involve a black or white background, professional studio lighting and you.	Outdoor Photo Shoots This is a more relaxed photo shoot environment, lighting is less controlled and your photos will have interesting varied backgrounds.

4. Viewing Session

Between a few days or weeks after the shoot, we will meet with you to go through the photos and select your prints. You may also make new orders for more prints in this time. Please note that all major decision makers need to be present at this session (ie, if gran wants some photos of her grandchildren, have her at the viewing session so that she may place her order). Extras purchased will be invoiced separately.
